We form a wide circle around the room and say:

Everything is yours, God everything comes from you: all we have we offer to you. Accept our love, God we pray; receive our gifts, God today.

God of all life, you give us this diverse and beautiful earth to discover and explore and cherish. You give us friends, families and strangers, you give us happy times and things to celebrate. And you give us your love, in times of both joy and sadness.

In Jesus you felt our hurt and pain; through him you wipe away our tears and fill us with your peace. You offer us a taste of your new creation, a feast for all your children.

You made us all, each wonderfully different, to join with the angels and sing your praise:

Holy, holy, holy God God of heaven and earth adored, ceasing never, God for ever, holy, holy God

Holy God, in the breaking of bread Jesus shows himself among us. Eating with his disciples, he took bread and gave you thanks; he broke it and said, 'This is my body, which is given for you. Do this to remember me.'
